## Safety Plan

- 1. This Safety Plan is for the DPGC Event to be held on 17 September 2016. The racing course will be conducted on Restronguet Creek as indicated by the Start/Finish line and the two marks.
- 2. All members of DPGC are to monitor safety. Coxes are reminded that although racing, the normal anti-collision precautions and "rules of the road" still applies, as does the routine safety rules when on the water as a part of rowing for any CPGA affiliated Club. All Gigs will launch and land at Grid SW 7979338905 (immediately in front of the refreshment tents).
- 3. The Accident and emergency procedure is as follows. Paramedic will be at the launch/landing area. Access for the emergency services is SW 7979338945, the gate to the Quay will be unlocked during racing. The Ambulance should be directed to the East end of "Quay Road, Devoran, TR3 6PW" to gain access to the Quay.
- 4. Emergency on water, Cox will radio starter and advise on nature of emergency. Raise oars and the Rib will evacuate casualty from the Gig to the landing area for medical treatment.
- 5. Any minor injuries must be brought to the attention of the CPGA Safety Officer for reporting purposes, regardless of the level of medical assistance provided.
- 6. Adverse weather conditions will, depending upon the severity, curtail or cease the activity on water. The DPGC Safety Officer will decide at the time if it is appropriate to stop racing.
- 7. High tide is at 1733hrs UTC (5.5m) Falmouth.
